Purpose: To provide affordable, flexible loan capital to help create and expand small businesses located in Alamosa, Costilla, and Saguache Counties.

Partners: CEF will work with local banks, economic development agencies, ag-industry associations, main street organizations and the San Luis Valley Small Business Development Center to develop and sustain locally-owned small businesses.

Who can apply: New or existing businesses that are not able to obtain bank financing due to lack of collateral or down payment; primary office or operations must be located in Alamosa, Costilla or Saguache County.

Loan Amounts: From \$1,000 to \$250,000

Loan Rates and Terms: Competitive with terms up to 10 years depending on loan size and use of funds

Loan Uses: Working capital, equipment, inventory, property improvements, business purchase, and commercial real estate (gap financing)
